Clinical Research Fellowship

Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada

The Mental Health and Addictions Clinical Research Fellowship is designed for a physician to train as a Clinician-Scientist with a goal of developing a career in tertiary mental health care research.

Eligibility requirements

At the time of taking up the Fellowship, the candidate must have completed residency or equivalent training in Psychiatry. The candidate must be eligible for an Educational or Full License to practice in the Province of British Columbia.

Closing date

The closing date for applications is December 1, 2006. Announcement of the award will be made by February 1, 2007. The start date will be July 1, 2007.

Application

The application materials consist of:

- The applicant's curriculum vitae formatted according the Common CV-CIHR format
- The proposed mentor's curriculum vitae formatted according the Common CV-CIHR format
- The CIHR Training Module pages 6-9
- Three Sponsor's reports (CIHR format)
- Official transcripts from the applicant's Medical School and undergraduate training.

Location of tenure

The mentor is required to have an affiliation with BC Mental Health & Addiction Services. The training may take place at the Riverview Hospital site and PHSA Mental Health facilities including future redevelopment sites and specifically UBC Hospital and Vancouver General Hospital.

Compensation

The Fellowship salary will be \$100,000 per year for 2 years. The Fellow may generate additional income from clinical practice up to a maximum of one day per week. A \$5000 yearly research allowance will be provided.
